Instructions to make the patches for the 'T' Shirt







The following instructions would be great for those who have a favourite shirt and have a mark which you cannot wash out

- 1. Cut small squares of white and beige colours, some of the squares can be larger than others whatever takes your fancy
- 2. I attached the squares down with "Painters Tape" this helps keeping the squares in place
- 3. Stitch each of the squares as you go



4. Cut the frayed edges away from each of the square blocks



5. Over each of the blocks you stitched down using a straight stitch then zigzag around the edges
